

A.L.M.A. CANADA INC. 2025-2026 STUDENT BURSARY APPLICATION GUIDELINES

A. BURSARIES AVAILABLE

3 CEGEP - \$ 750 each

- 3 University Bachelor: \$1,500 each
- 1 University Master: \$2,000
- 1 University or recognized Institute for Italian Studies Italian Language: \$500
- 1 Technical Trade School (program 3 months to 3 years): \$750

B. QUALIFYING STUDENTS

- Full-time University students at the under-graduate, graduate or post-graduate studies level.
- Full-time students enrolled at a CEGEP or Grade 12, or other recognized post-secondary institution.

B1. ITALIAN LANGUAGE BURSARY QUALIFYING STUDENTS MUST:

- be a full or part-time university student.
- have successfully completed or be in the process of completing a 6 credit Italian course at the university level.

B2. TECHNICAL TRADE APPLICANTS

• See requirements below.

C. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Each student must:

- be a full-time student;
- be a Canadian citizen;
- have at least one legal guardian such as a parent or a grandparent of Marchigiani origin or descent;
- be a member in good standing as follows:

* A student who is 25 years old as of **January 1, 2025** must have his/her own membership for the year 2025; a parent's membership may be provided for the years **2024** and **2023**;

* A student under the age of 25 as of December 31, 2024 must be in good standing with their parents' memberships for (3) consecutive years, **2023**, **2024**, **2025**.

Please note that only applicants who meet all eligibility and documentation requirements will be considered by the Bursary Committee. All other applicants will be disqualified without exception.

D. APPLICATION FORM AND DOCUMENTATION REQUIREMENTS

1. The **fully completed bursary application form**, along with the required official documentation, must be received by the A.L.M.A. Bursary Committee on or prior to **Tuesday, September 30th, 2025. Please note that this date is final.** ** Extension of a maximum of 2 weeks will be granted for receipt of official transcript and letters of recommendations ONLY.

2. A complete ***official transcript*** of marks as of the last complete semester preceding the due date of the application must be forwarded directly to the A.L.M.A. Bursary Committee. (*Copies will not be accepted.*)

3. An ***official certificate of admission*** to a regular full-time program for the upcoming academic year must be forwarded directly to the A.L.M.A. Bursary Committee. *(Copies will not be accepted.)*

4. * LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION* - CEGEP or Grade 12, UNIVERSITY, TECHNICAL TRADE SCHOOL and ITALIAN LANGUAGE applications require one (1) letter of recommendation which must be forwarded directly to the A.L.M.A. Bursary Committee. This letter must be written by an individual (preferably professor/teacher) who can attest to the student's academic abilities and should come from a non-related individual. NOTE: If the student is in the first year of their program, we will accept reference letter from their previous institution.

5. A passport size photo must be included with application.

E. BURSARY APPLICATIONS AND SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION

Bursary applications and supporting documentation must be sent by registered mail with receipt confirmation to the address below. Alternately, we will also accept electronic and/or hand delivered applications.

F. MAXIMUM BURSARIES PER CANDIDATE

- 1. A.L.M.A. CANADA accepts only one bursary application of any type per student per year.
- 2. The maximum number of bursaries awarded to any student will be one for each of the following levels:
 - CEGEP or Grade 12
 - University
 - Master
 - University or recognized Institute for Italian Studies Italian Language
 - Technical Trade School

Please note that a student who has previously won any of the above bursaries will no longer be eligible as a candidate for that particular bursary.

THE QUIRINO PULCINI TRADE BURSARY APPLICATION GUIDELINES

QUALIFYING STUDENTS

Each student must:

- be a full or part-time student in a trade program.
- be taking trade course in the current year.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Each student must:

- be a full or part-time student;
- be a Canadian citizen;
- have at least one legal guardian such as parents or grandparents of Marchigiani origin or descent;
- be a member in good standing as follows:

* A student who is 25 years old as of **January 1, 2025** must have his/her own membership for the year 2025; a parent's membership may be provided for the years **2024** and **2023**;

* A student under the age of 25 as of December 31, 2024 must be in good standing with their parents' memberships for (3) consecutive years, **2023**, **2024**, **2025**.

APPLICATION FORM AND DOCUMENTATION REQUIREMENTS
